In May of 2014, the EPOA and resident Bill Bellmer made a proposal to the traffic commission, a simple proposal to clear the Clinton/Stewart intersection after the light turns red. The traffic commission studied it, got input from the GC police, and in June passed the request on to Nassau County.

Nassau County did not seek any further input from the EPOA and in April proposed this massive remake, virtually identical to their 1997 proposal that GC rejected. It's a safety, environmental and property value disaster for the East. Incredibly, after the County spends \$3 million, this "failed" intersection would remain a "failed" intersection, with even more cars and trucks moving faster thru additional lanes past Stewart School and our homes.

The EPOA, in a unanimous vote of its directors, is asking the BOT to reject the County plan.

The board of directors of the Eastern Property Owners' Association requests that the Garden City Board of Trustees reject the current proposal as presented by Nassau County that would remake the intersection of Clinton Road and Stewart Avenue.

This room is packed with outraged residents who oppose this plan. Hundreds of residents, from all over the Village, not just the East, have signed petitions against it. Over the last 48 hours the EPOA through our website has received over 75 emails from residents appalled by this plan. You don't have to live near this intersection to appreciate that it is an assault on our quality of life. The EPOA is grateful to the Central Property Owners' Association and the many Village residents who have written to say so.

Please listen to the taxpaying families who live here and tell the County no.
