What you may expect during construction:

- National Grid crews generally work between the hours of 8 am - 4 pm Monday through Friday. (occasional non-weekday work may be required)
- Traffic will remain open during construction hours. All work will be done in the median on Stewart Avenue. A traffic flagger will be on-site during work hours to safely direct vehicles.
- Safety is our priority, please be mindful of the site during and after construction hours.
